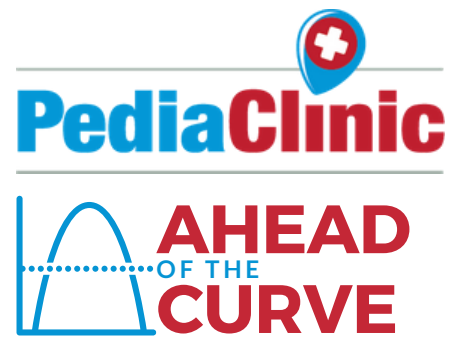


Rapid Testing for COVID-19



For who?

DCSD Students, Teachers & Family Members

Do you have these symptoms?

- Fever
- Cough
- Colds
- Headache
- Diarrhea
- Shortness of breath
- Sore throat
- Loss of taste and/or smell

Have you had exposure?

- Exposure to a person with confirmed COVID-19
- Exposure to a Person Under Investigation (PUI) for COVID-19

Is this test more accurate?

YES! The MOLECULAR COVID-19 rapid test amplifies the viral material millions of times like the PCR test does. Results are available in 3 to 15 minutes.. Tri-County Health recognizes its ability to identify a true positive case

Do I need an appointment?

YES! Please go to www.pediaclinic.net to make an appointment. A telehealth visit is necessary before receiving the test.

How much does it cost?

Most insurance companies cover the test and a telehealth visit without a copay. If you do not have insurance, our staff can make arrangements for financial assistance during your telehealth visit.
